Office Support

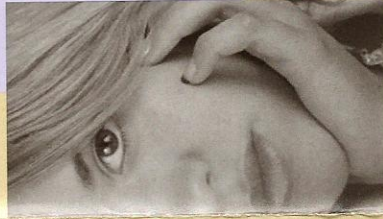
Office Support Volunteers must be at least 18 years of age and willing to provide assistance in the Center when needed.
